



# Event Entry Terms & Conditions

## INTRODUCTION

The following sets out the Terms and Conditions which person agrees to at the point of entry. Each participant is required to accept these terms before an entry will be accepted and processed.

## MINIMUM AGE RESTRICTIONS BY DISTANCE

Children under the age of 15 must be accompanied by an adult who has also registered in the same challenge.

## ENTRY DETAILS

An email address is required for all entrants. All correspondences will be via email. The Belvoir Challenge cannot be responsible for information not being passed to entrants due to incorrect email addresses.

All entrants must acknowledge and agree that personal information collected during registration can be stored in connection of the administration and organisation of the event. For more information we encourage you to read our [Privacy Policy](#).

At the total discretion of the organisers all entry fees are non-refundable, non-deferrable and non-transferrable.

## YOUR HEALTH

The Belvoir Challenge is a physically active event. You accept you take part entirely at your own risk and it is your responsibility to ensure you are fit and able to take part in the event. Please do not take part if you are unwell. Each participant must agree to the disclaimer on these Terms and Conditions before participating in the event. All participants understand they take part at their own risk and that no person(s) or organisation(s) will be held responsible for any accident, injury or loss, prior to, during or after the event. The Friend of Harby School charity and its volunteers do not accept responsibility for injury, loss and damage sustained by a participant unless the above injury, loss and damage is proven to be caused as a direct result of negligence on the part of the organisers.

Should you sustain an injury, you consent to receiving any medical treatment including ambulance transportation that the event organisers think advisable.

## RACE DAY

By taking part, all participants confirm they are happy for their names and any footage or photographs taken during their participation to be used to on social media and any other form of marketing.

Participants must follow all instructions given by marshals or event officials including volunteers, medial staff throughout the duration of the event.

Numbered bibs are specific personal identifiers which are specific to the person registered. They cannot be exchanged, given, or sold to another person without updating their personal details with the event organisers. The bibs must be worn on the front of the person. No participant shall be permitted in the event without the appropriate bib number.

Event officials reverse the right to delay, postpone, cancel, alter the route, or not officially time the race in adverse weather conditions or other events outside the organiser control. The determination of what constitutes this is reversed by the organising committee.

Because of the method the food provided is prepared and cooked, we cannot guarantee that traces of food you may be allergic to are not present. By eating the food served during and after the Belvoir Challenge you accept that this is entirely at your own risk.

### **REFUND AND TRANSFER POLICY**

Like most mass participation events we are unable to offer refunds on entries fees even in the case of an event cancellation. However, you do have options including transferring your entry to another person or deferring to the next year's event. For full information and eligibility please see our [Cancellation Policy](#). Each request is individual and as such will be assessed on an individual basis.

### **AMENDING YOUR ENTRY**

You can amend your entry at anytime up to the point where registration is 'locked down'. Registration is locked down so the event organisers can process all the entries, send out race packs and finalise check in. Registration is generally locked down 2 weeks before the event. Anyone wishing to amend their entry after this time will need to do so on the morning of the event. There is an administration charge to do this.

### **MERCHANDISE**

If for any reason you are not satisfied with any official Belvoir Merchandise you may exchange on the day of the event or return it within 15 days for exchange or refund providing the goods are unused and have their original tags. We are unable to accept back any goods which have been worn or laundered, unless they are faulty. Any postage charged at the time of sale is non-refundable.
